

Policy Title: PRESIDENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The President is the chief executive officer of the College. The President is the Board's single official link with the College as an organization. The President is accountable to the Board acting as a collective body. The Board will direct the President through written policies and establishment of goals. The President's responsibilities are:

- College operation within the boundaries established in Board policies on Board-President Relationship and Executive Parameters.
- Accomplishment of the responsibilities set forth in the President's job description.
- Accomplishment of annual goals and objectives established by the Board in consultation with the President.

The President has three major functions:

- Provide leadership and direction so that the organization has a continuous and effective effort to accomplish the College Mission and Vision, Strategic Directions and Key Results.
- Provide leadership and direction so that College operation is within the boundaries established in Board policies on Board-President Relationship and Executive Parameters.
- Represent the College to the general public and its diverse constituencies. The Board as a collective body will assess presidential performance in meeting the above responsibilities through a formal review each June. The President's performance will be considered synonymous with the organizational performance of the College as a whole.
