This application form is the first step toward admission to the college.

General Instructions

- Complete all sections of the application.
- Print clearly.
- Consult Mid-State for application dates, specific program (major) information, and other details.
- Apply early!

Application includes a \$30 application fee.

- Attach the \$30 nonrefundable application fee. Send a check or money order payable to Mid-State Technical College. Do not send cash.
 - Application fee may be waived if you are receiving public assistance.
- You will need to submit the application fee if you are returning to Mid-State after two semesters or one year of inactivity.
- You may complete the application without paying this fee, but we will not consider your application complete until you do.
- Disregard the application fee if you are applying as a non-degree-seeking student.

Application will ask you to designate a program of study (a major).

- If you haven't chosen a program of study, please designate Undecided.
- Your selection is only your initial program of study designation.
- You can change your program of study during the advising phase of the admissions process.

When application is complete:

- An academic advisor will contact you to guide you through the rest of the admissions process.

Assessment

- If you've taken the Accuplacer or ACT assessment in the past five years, submit your scores to Admissions. If required course scores are not met, students may remediate in the LiNK and retest. Assessment results are used for placement into appropriate courses. Under certain circumstances, the Accuplacer may be waived for course admissions. For Accuplacer waiver guidelines, go to mstc.edu/accuplacerwaiver.
- If you do not have ACT or Accuplacer scores that are less than five years old, contact the Mid-State Testing Center at 715.422.5443.
- Accommodations are available for students with special needs.
